

## Animal: *Lions*



Colour	Golden Brown with a pale underside, males have a mane.
Shape	Muscular body with a large head and a long tail.
Size	Male: 4.5 to 6.5 feet Female: 4.5 to 5.5 feet
Weight	Males: 330 to 550 pounds Females: 260 to 400 pounds
Diet	Carnivorous – mainly hunt large herbivores like Antelopes and Zebras.
Habitat	Savannah, Grasslands, and open Woodlands in Africa.
Fun Fact	Lions are the only cats that live in social groups called Prides.

## *Animal: Elephants*



<i>Colour</i>	<i>Grey but their skin can look brown or muddy after a bath.</i>
<i>Shape</i>	<i>Large thick body with long trunks and big ears.</i>
<i>Size</i>	<i>Up to 13 feet tall at the shoulder.</i>
<i>Weight</i>	<i>Up to 6000 to 14000 pounds.</i>
<i>Diet</i>	<i>Herbivores – they eat grass, fruit bark, and roots.</i>
<i>Habitat</i>	<i>Savannah, Grasslands, and Forests in Africa and Asia.</i>
<i>Fun Fact</i>	<i>Elephants have excellent memories and can remember water sources and routes for years.</i>

## Animal: Giraffes



Colour	Yellow brown with large patches of white or cream.
Shape	Tall body with a very long neck and legs.
Size	14 to 18 feet tall.
Weight	Up to 2400 to 3000 pounds.
Diet	Herbivores mostly eat leaves, particularly from the Acacia trees.
Habitat	Grasslands, and Open Woodlands in Sub-Saharan Africa.
Fun Fact	Giraffes are the tallest land animals and can run up to a speed of 35 miles per hour.

## Animal: Dolphins



Colour	Grey, blue-grey, or dark blue with a lighter belly.
Shape	Streamlined body with a fin on the back and a long snout.
Size	8 to 12 feet tall.
Weight	300 to 1400 pounds.
Diet	Carnivorous – primarily fish and squid.
Habitat	Oceans and seas around the world.
Fun Fact	Dolphins are highly intelligent and can communicate with each other using a variety of sounds.

## Animal: Kangaroos



Colour	Brown, Grey or Reddish Brown.
Shape	Strong hind legs, a long tail and a small head.
Size	3 to 8 feet in leg including the tail.
Weight	50 to 200 pounds.
Diet	Herbivores – mainly grasses, shrubs and leaves.
Habitat	Open plains, grasslands and forests in Australia.
Fun Fact	Kangaroos use their powerful tails while hopping to keep their balance.
