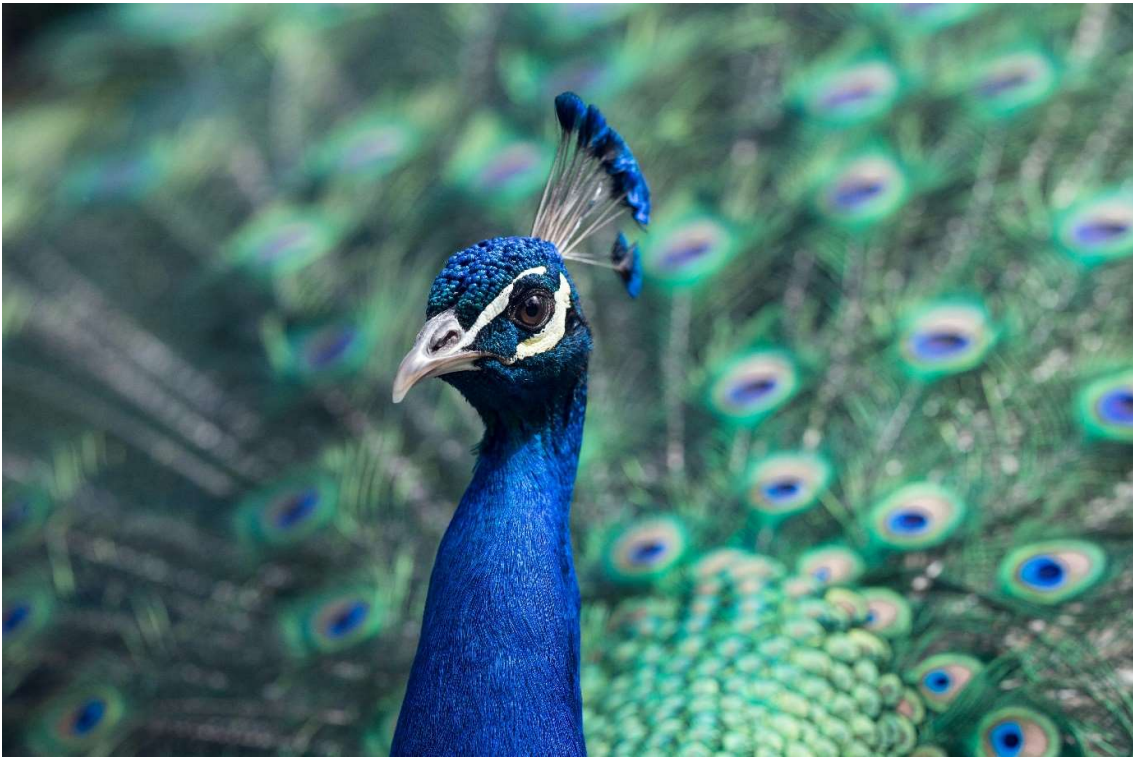


Bird: Sparrow



Colour	Brown and White with Black Markings.
Size	Small, about 16cm long.
Habitat	Cities, Villages and Countryside.
Food	Seeds, Insects, and Small Grains.
Fun Fact	Sparrows are social birds and often live in groups called Flocks.

Bird: Peacock



Colour	Bright Blue and Green with a fan-shaped tail.
Size	Medium to large up to 100cm.
Habitat	Forests, Farmlands and Gardens.
Food	Seeds, Fruits, and Small Insects.
Fun Fact	The Peacock is India's national bird, and its beautiful tail feathers are used in dances.

Bird: Eagle



Colour	Mostly Brown with a Whitehead (e.g. Bald Eagle)
Size	Large Wingspan up to 2.3m.
Habitat	Mountains, Forests, and Open Landscapes.
Food	Fish, small Mammals and other Birds.
Fun Fact	Eagles have sharp eyes and can spot their prey from up to 3km.

Bird: Penguin



Colour	Black and white with some yellow or orange accents (Varies upon the species).
Size	Small to Medium, 40cm to 1m tall.
Habitat	Cold Regions, especially Antarctica.
Food	Fish, Squid, and Krill.
Fun Fact	Penguins can't fly but they are excellent swimmers and can fly underwater.

Bird: Owl



Colour	Shades of brown, white, or grey with big, round eyes.
Size	Small to Large, 20cm to 70cm tall.
Habitat	Forests, Deserts and even urban areas.
Food	Small Mammals, Insects and Birds.
Fun Fact	Owls can turn their heads all the way around, almost up to 270 degrees, to look for their prey.
